

REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION OF THE “BBB CHALLENGE — EPISODE 3” EVENT

1. The Organizer of the Event known as “BBB Challenge — Episode 3” is a private individual, whose actions — in cooperation with a group of players associated under the name “BBB” (Black Bordered Boomers) — aims to introduce the intricacies of playing Magic: The Gathering to players by enabling physical gameplay thanks to organizing live meetings.
2. The Organizer of the Event reserves the right to change these regulations at any time.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse participation in the Event to any person, without stating reasons. In such case, any entry fee paid shall be refunded in full to the account from which the payment was made.
4. Registration in “BBB Challenge — Episode 3” Event constitutes acknowledgment and acceptance of these regulations.
5. Participation in the Event (including being a spectator) constitutes consent to the use of one’s image for promotional purposes.
6. Participation in the Event constitutes consent to the publication of the supplied decklist for a given tournament.
7. The Event will take place at the premises of Polish-Japanese Academy of Information Technology, located at Koszykowowa 86, Warsaw, on August 28–30, 2026.
8. Registration for a given tournament (Old School, Premodern, and Legacy), conducted by filling the application form, starts on April 1st, 2026, and will continue until August 27th, 2026.
9. The entry fee changes over time¹.
10. The entry fee should be paid from the account of the person registering for the tournament. On the day of the tournament, the Organizer reserves the right to verify the person’s identity to confirm payment. Any discrepancies may lead to disqualification, in which case the entry fee (treated as organizational cost) will not be refunded.
11. Minors should make the transfer from their legal guardian’s account, and include full names of the participant and the guardian in the transfer reason. On the day of the tournament, the participant should be accompanied by their legal guardian. Point 10. of the regulations also concerns the legal guardian and the tournament’s participant.
12. In the event of withdrawal from participation, the registration fee may be transferred to another person. In such cases, the player must contact the Organizer. Such request must be submitted before August 21, 2026.
13. If a participant knows they will be unable to attend the tournament despite having paid the registration fee, the Organizer requests that they notify the Organizer in advance in order to facilitate the efficient organization of the Event.
14. The Organizer does not provide parking facilities or accommodation at the venue.
15. The Organizer does not provide any catering during the Event, unless the temperature during tournament days reaches 30°C — in those cases, the Organizer shall supply water bottles in number at least equal to the number of players.
16. At the venue, where “BBB Challenge — Episode 3” Event takes place, there is an absolute ban on smoking cigarettes, tobacco products, e-cigarettes, and other smoke-producing substances.
17. At the venue, where “BBB Challenge — Episode 3” Event takes place, there is an absolute ban on alcohol consumption.
18. It is noted that points 16. and 17. apply not only to the buildings, but also to the entire area of Polish-Japanese Academy of Information Technology in Warsaw.
19. The Organizer reserves the right to deny entrance and participation to intoxicated persons.
20. The Organizer reserves the right to deny entrance and participation to persons who may cause nervous atmosphere among the participants.

21. The Organizer kindly requests that all participants observe standards of personal conduct during the Event. Any report submitted to the judges or the Organizer regarding insulting, threatening, or abusive behavior will be reviewed on-site in the presence of the parties concerned. As a result of such review, a participant (or a spectator) may be removed from the venue under the procedures set forth in 10.
22. The Organizer kindly requests that all participants adhere to the principles of fair play.
23. The Organizer and the tournament staff do not take any responsibility for personal items left in the venue by players (or spectators).
24. The tournament will be REL: Competitive, with number of rounds dependent on the player count.
25. The accepted number of proxy cards is:
 - 100% for the Old School tournament.
 - 30%, rounded down, for the Legacy tournament.
 - 0% for the Premodern tournament.
26. *Gold border* cards are allowed for the Premodern tournament.
27. The Organizer kindly requests that players who print proxies ensure that they are legible, printed in color and in their original printing². Proxies that do not meet those requirements may be rejected for use.
28. Decklists should be printed in a legible manner, and supplied to judges during the tournament day. Illegible decklists may result in the player being issued a penalty of the Tournament Error — Decklist Problem category (Game Loss).
29. Proxy cards should be clearly marked in decklists.
30. The administrator of your personal data is Adunet, 04-359 Warsaw, ul. Kobielska 19.

Categories of Personal Data: name and surname, email, phone number.

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6. par.1 lit. f (legitimate interest).

Recipients of your personal data may be external entities processing data on behalf of the Administrator based on entrustment agreements.

Your personal data will be stored until the end of the event and for the time resulting from the limitation

period for claims, keeping accounts, or other rights in this regard.

At any time, you can request the deletion of your data, access to it, its rectification, transfer, and objection to processing. You can exercise your rights at the Administrator’s headquarters or electronically by writing to the email address: iod@adunet.pl. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if you believe that your data is being processed in violation of the GDPR.

Your data is not subject to automated processing.
